## Outgoing Mobility:

### 1. Students studying at the University of Belgrade

If you are granted an Erasmus+ scholarship for one semester or the whole academic year to go and study abroad you will receive:

- Subsistence allowance:

Denmark, Ireland, France, Italy, Austria, Finland, Sweden, United Kingdom, Liechtenstein, Norway	<b>850 EUR</b>
Belgium, Czech Republic, Germany, Greece, Spain, Croatia, Cyprus, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Portugal, Slovenia, Iceland, Turkey	<b>800 EUR</b>
Bulgaria, Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Hungary, Malta, Poland, Romania, Slovakia, former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia	<b>750 EUR</b>

### 2. Staff (Teaching and Administrative) working at the University of Belgrade

If you are granted an Erasmus+ scholarship for mobility you will receive:

- Subsistence allowance:

Host country	Per day
Denmark, Ireland, Netherlands, Sweden, United Kingdom	<b>160 EUR</b>
Belgium, Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Greece, France, Italy, Cyprus, Luxembourg, Hungary, Austria, Poland, Romania, Finland, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, Turkey	<b>140 EUR</b>
Germany, Spain, Latvia, Malta, Portugal, Slovakia, Macedonia	<b>120 EUR</b>
Estonia, Croatia, Lithuania, Slovenia	<b>100 EUR</b>

Note: If mobility period is longer than 14 days: Up to and including the 14th day of activity you will get 100% of Subsistence allowance. For every additional day you will receive 70% of Subsistence allowance.
